

## Parkman Township Trustees

Special Meeting of July 31, 2012

A special meeting of the Parkman Township Trustees for the purpose of putting a resolution on the November, 2012 ballot for a road and bridge levy renewal was called to order at 7:25 p.m. In attendance were Trustees-Patrick Joyce, Kevin O'Reilly, and Nancy Ferguson, Fiscal Officer-Joyce Peters, Secretary-Renee Patry, Tom Evers, and Jon Ferguson. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Nancy Ferguson moved the adoption of the following resolution: Whereas, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of said Parkman Township, Geauga County, Ohio; therefore, be it resolved, by the Board of Trustees of the township of Parkman, Geauga County, Ohio, two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring, that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of Parkman Township for the purpose of the general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads and bridges in Parkman Township as provided for in O.R.C. section 5705.19 (G) at a rate not exceeding 1.5 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to fifteen cents (\$.15) for each hundred dollars of valuation, for a period of five (5) years and which levy is a renewal of an existing levy of 1.5 mills. Resolved, that the question of levying additional taxes be submitted to the electors of said Parkman Township at the general election to be held at the usual voting places within said Parkman Township on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2012; and be it further resolved, that said levy be placed upon the tax list of the current year after the February settlement next succeeding the election, if a majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof; and be it further resolved, That the Clerk or Township Fiscal Officer of this Township be and he is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Board of Elections, Geauga County, Ohio, on or before August 8, 2012 and notify said Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law. Patrick Joyce seconded the motion and the roll being called upon its adoption the vote resulted as follows: Kevin O'Reilly-yes, Patrick Joyce-yes, and Nancy Ferguson-yes. (Resolution No. 12-161) Motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Nancy Ferguson and seconded by Patrick Joyce to adjourn the meeting at 7:30 p.m. (Resolution No. 12-162) Motion carried unanimously.
