

PARKMAN TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES

Special Meeting of January 17, 2013

The candidates were each given time to introduce themselves, state qualifications, and reason for seeking the position. Following the introductions members of the public were allowed to ask one question of the applicants. The applicants answered the public questions and questions from the Board of Trustees.

Nancy Ferguson said that an applicant for Board of Trustees is required to be 18 years old or older, a resident of the Township and a registered voter. Roger Anderson withdrew his application because he was not aware of the registered voter requirement.

Nancy Ferguson asked Kevin O'Reilly if he could pick his top 3 or 4 choices of the applicants. Kevin O'Reilly said he had listened and reviewed the applications. Kevin O'Reilly nominated Lucinda Sharp-Gates for the vacant Trustee position. Nancy Ferguson did not second the nomination. After additional discussion they were unable to come to an agreement.

A motion was made by Kevin O'Reilly and seconded by Nancy Ferguson to adjourn the meeting at 8:15 p.m. (Resolution No.13-43) Motion carried unanimously.
